

Understanding the Price of Poverty

Attend This Poverty Simulation to Experience the Realities Faced by Many of Your Neighbors.



Crisis Control Ministry encourages you to join them for this meaningful experience. During this simulation, you will walk in the shoes of families living on or near the poverty level.

No community is immune to poverty. The poverty simulation is one way we can bring awareness to individuals in our community who may not have the opportunity to experience households outside of their socioeconomic peer group. Through these simulations participants experience a first-person perspective of what it is like to be facing a financial crisis.

During the simulation, participants will be lead through a guided experience where they will assume the role of a low-income family member trying to meet his/her obligations over four 15-minute weeks.
